Description

An unusual and stylish silver-plated wine bottle cradle in the form of a sleigh. Its purpose is to allow a bottle of wine or port to rest in the holder for a couple of hours so that the sediment can collect on one side and not cloud the wine.

Art Deco was a popular design style in the 1920s and '30s characterised especially by sleek geometric or stylised forms. It represented luxury, glamour, exuberance, and faith in social and technological progress.
