Description

Hand-forged antique silver cutlery set for 12 people in double-struck Victoria pattern and all made by Dudley & Cater over a short span of dates. The Victoria pattern, first produced in the 1830s is one of three to commemorate Queen Victoria's ascent to the throne, the other two being, unsurprisingly, Albert pattern and Prince's pattern.

Double-struck indicates that the design is struck on the front and back of each piece, requiring a heavier gauge of silver and therefore a sign of superior quality silver cutlery.

- 12 dessert forks
- 12 table soup spoons
- 12 dessert spoons
- 12 teaspoons

Antique knives rarely survive so we have completed this service with 12 pairs of new matching silver table and dessert knives with stainless steel blades making them dishwasher safe.
