Description

A stylish Art Deco period hand cut crystal jar and cover fitted with silver mounts and closure clip. There are starbursts cut into the base and cover. The body and cover are cut with chamfered square panels and vertical cross sections. This piece is suitable as a vanity jar for the dresser or bathroom, or was a container for sweets and biscuits.

Art Deco was a popular design style throughout Europe in the 1920s and '30s characterised especially by sleek geometric or stylised forms. It represented luxury, glamour, exuberance, and faith in social and technological progress
