Description

Displaying the epitome of stylish Art Deco design, this heavy-gauge crystal decanter features fan-shaped body, triangular facetted stopper and hallmarked silver collar; all design cues that typify the Art Deco era.

Art Deco was a popular design style in the 1920s and 1930s characterised especially by sleek geometric or stylised forms. It represented luxury, glamour, exuberance, and faith in social and technological progress. For that reason silver cocktail and barware were popular categories of goods to reflect the style of the time.
